

FRIDLEY FIRE IN MONTANA COMPARING ACTION VS INACTION



The above left was taken 1 week after Fridley Fire on private land. The photo on the right was taken 2 years after the fire on the same land. Dead and dying trees were removed immediately following the fire and the forest was treated and reseeded with native grasses. Habitat for cavity nesting birds has been left to ensure habitat is provided.



The photo above was taken 2 years after same wildfire on adjacent federal land where no recovery work has been done because it is a wilderness area. Wilderness areas are a valid federal land designation. This photo shows the contrast though when action is taken and when the area is left to recover on its own.
